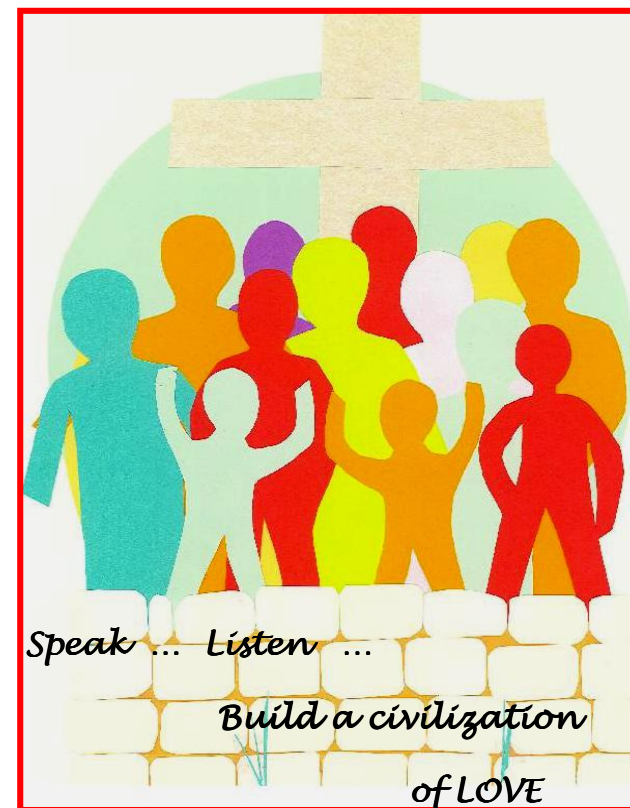

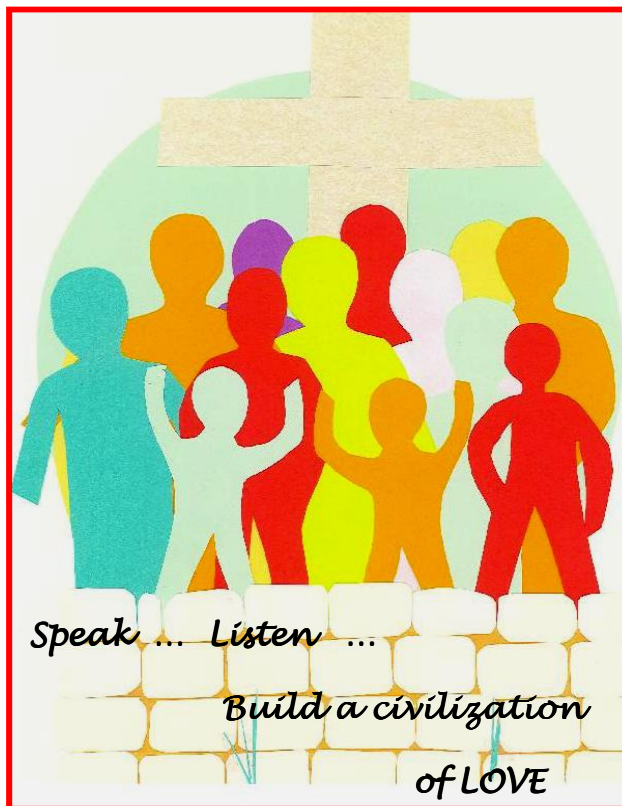
**DIOCESAN COMMISSION REPORTS:**
